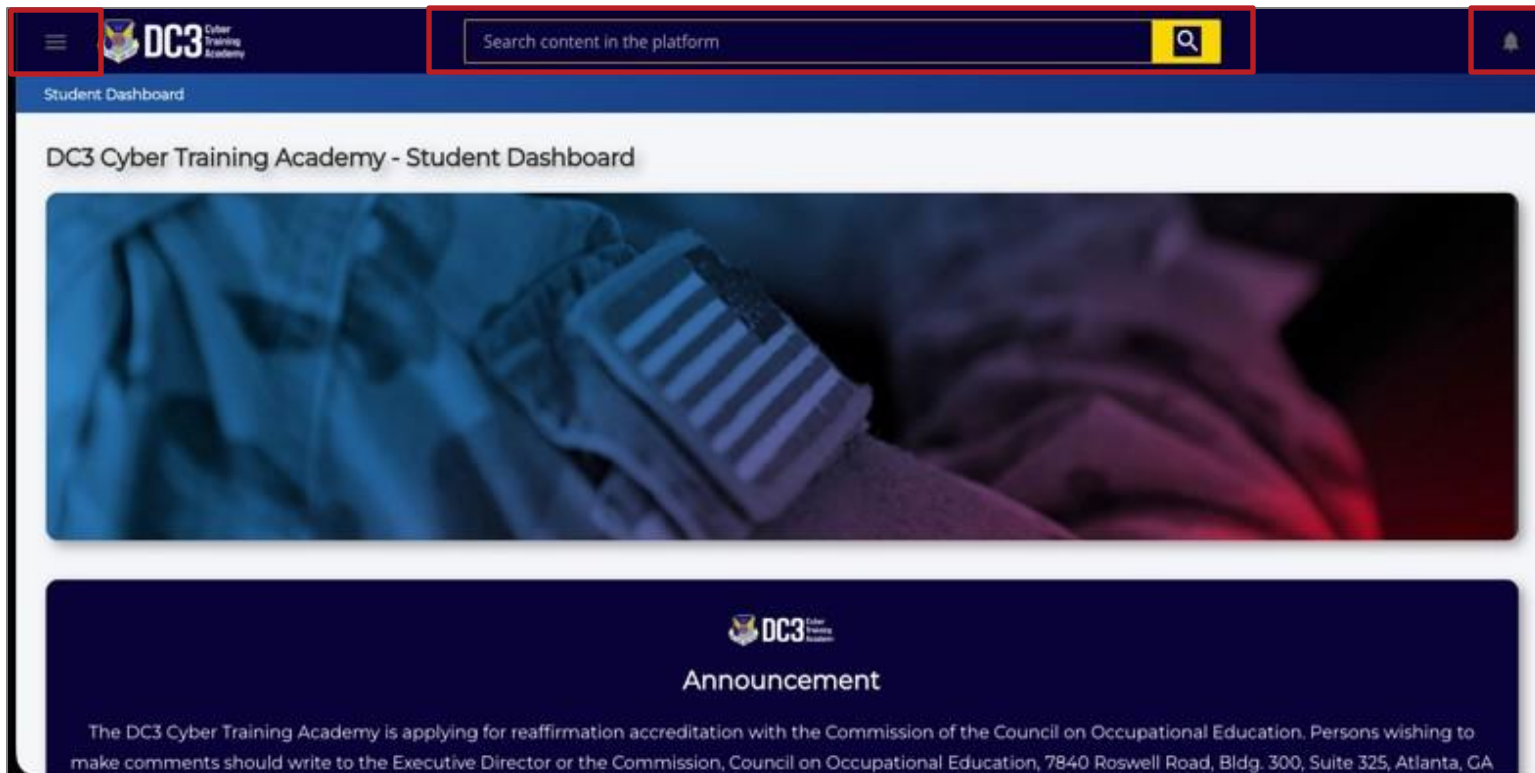


Discover the Updated DC3 CTA Cyber Training Environment

After registering for DC3 CTA Cyber Training Environment access with your CAC or PIV card, Students will be able to access an intuitive, self-service dashboard to facilitate your access to the the DC3 CTA course calendar, available course content, student transcripts, and other relevant DC3 CTA student resources.



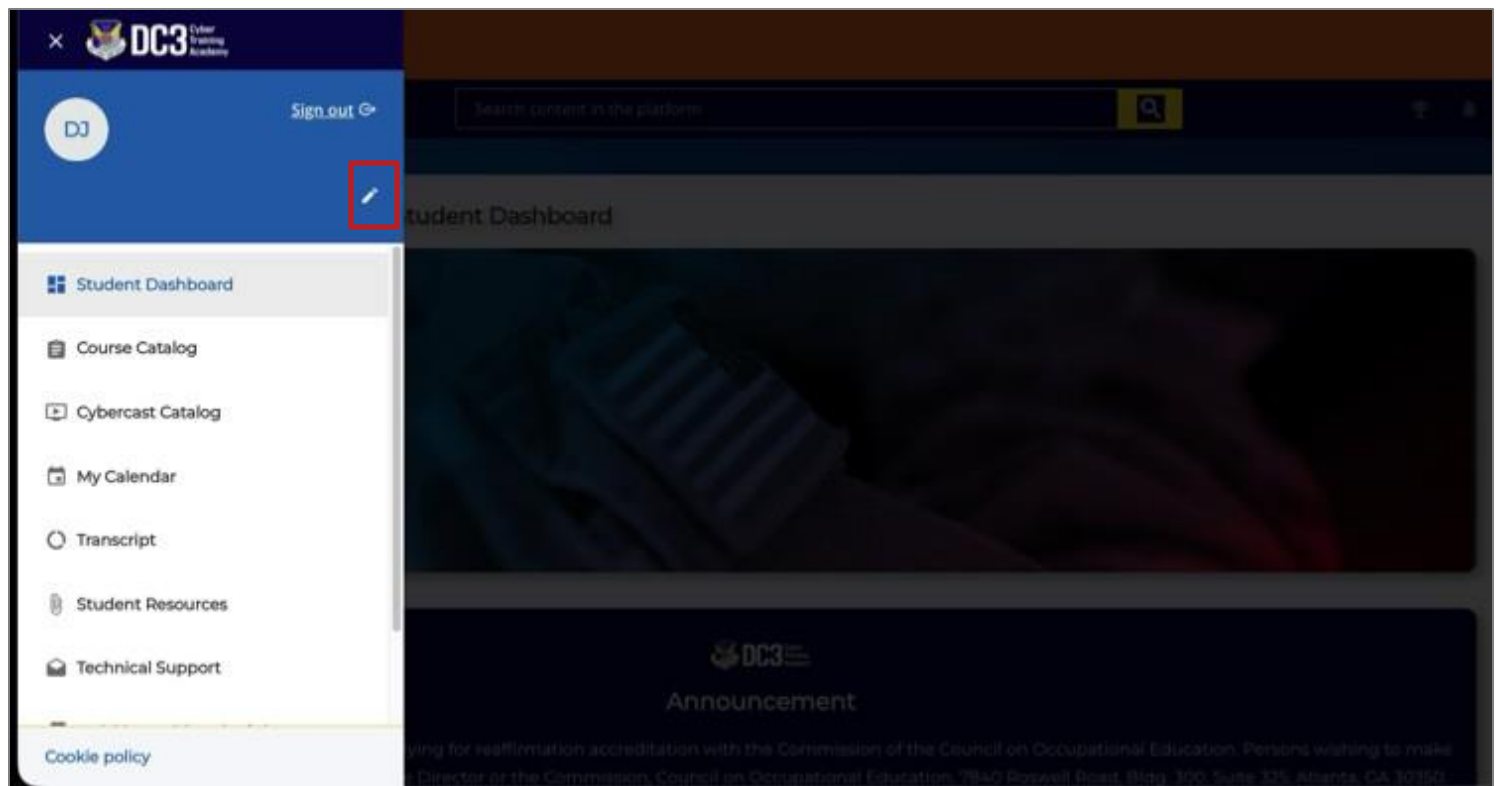
- Students can access the menu in the top left of the portal at any time to navigate to the platform's features.
- The search bar is also available to use from every platform screen.
- The bell icon in the top right of the portal provides Students with personalized notifications.

Scrolling down the Student Dashboard lets lets Students access the platform's major features. This includes direct access to courses for which a Student is enrolled or has in progress, a personalized calendar providing Students with direct access to session events. DC3 CTA Instructors keep Academy Quick Bytes up to date, highlighting industry trends as micro-learning modules for Students.

The Student Dashboard Provides Access to Important Platform Features

Within the Student Dashboard menu, Students have access to additional specialized features matching to common course access requests and Student services. From this menu, Students are able to access their user profile to keep information on contact information, supervisor contact, and employment status up to date.

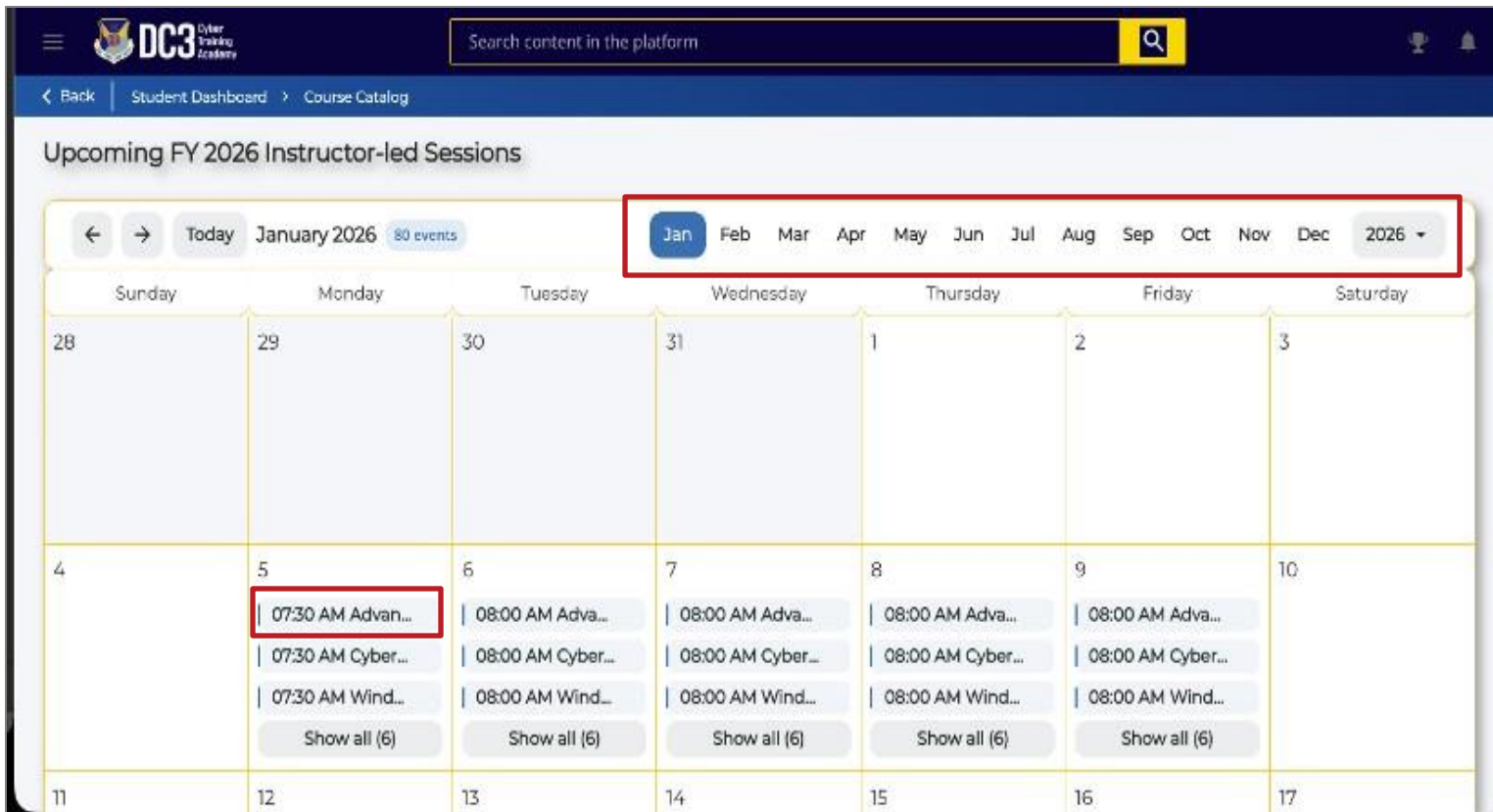
- The Student menu provides Students with access to DC3 CTA's Course Catalog and Cybercast Catalog.
- The menu provides Students with means for accessing their Transcripts.
- The menu provides Students with access to Student resources, including Academy policies.

The Course Catalog Assists Students with Course Discovery and Enrollment

The DC3 CTA Course Catalog is a typical starting point for new Students. DC3 CTA staff update the Course Catalog weekly. These updates reflect the schedule of Course Sessions up to 3 months (13 weeks) in advance of today's date. The Course Catalog feature provides detailed information on DC3 CTA's In-Residence, Instructor-Led, On-Demand course offerings.

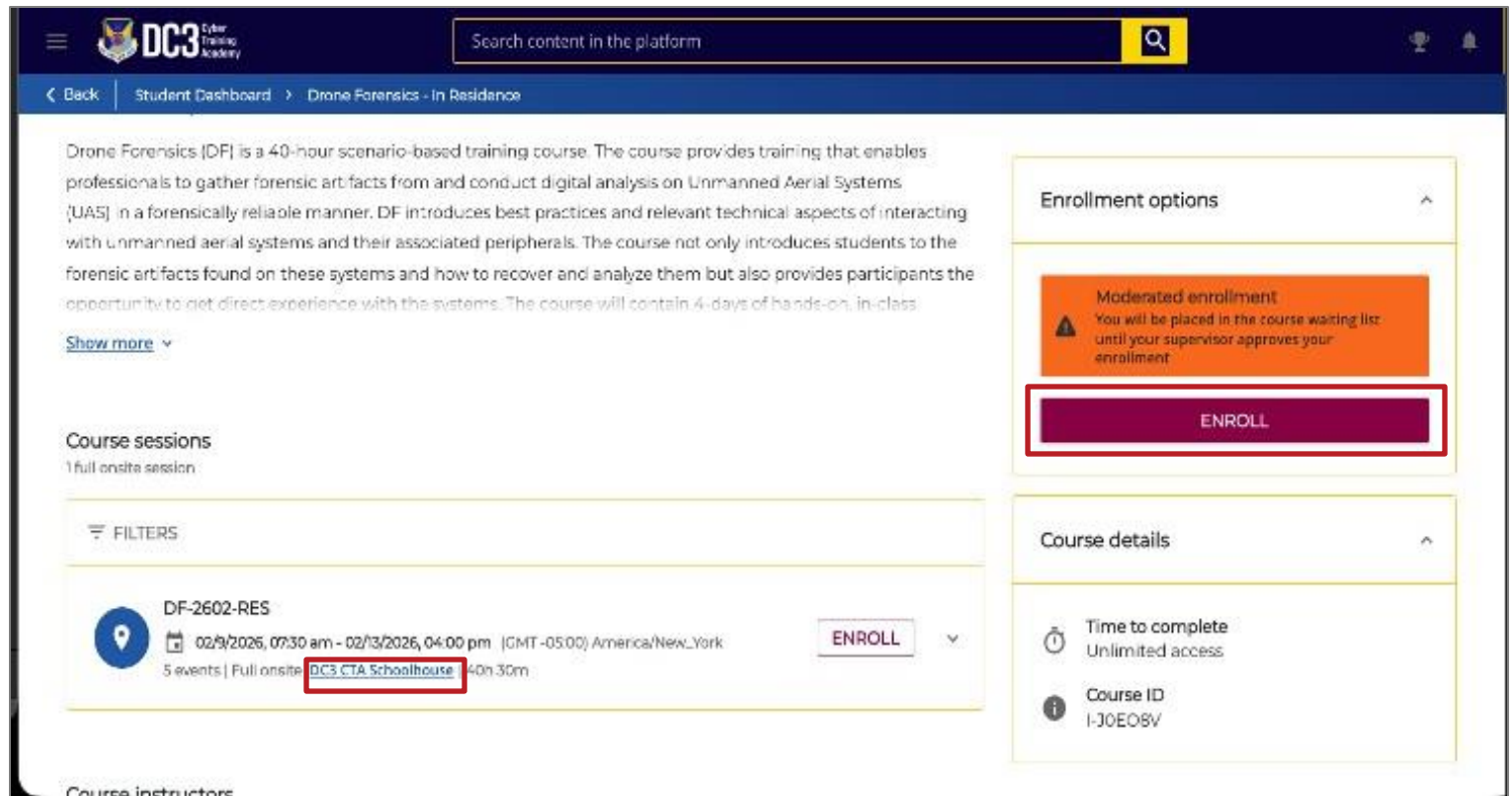
- Days and weeks with scheduled courses are displayed in the Course Calendar.

The Course Catalog Provides Further Detail on Courses and Available Sessions

More detailed course information is available to Students – either by selecting to view the course within the Course Catalog area or searching for it in the search bar. Detailed course information provides the ability for students to view scheduled sessions, enrollment policies, and additional information that can support enrolling in one or more DC3 CTA courses.

- Students will be able to see scheduled sessions available for enrollment.
- The course details also provide location information – a map with the Academy address or the virtual session link.
- Other detailed course information – including CEU eligibility – is also included.
